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# PARK TOWER

Modern urbanity suggested we live in large scale buildings surrounded by parks. The 20th century urbanization proved that postulate to be impossible and undesirable. The quantifiable qualities of light, air and views were weakened by the lack of social interaction the urban space offered. Instead the city developed densely pressing the public spaces away. Space consumption necessarily created dense urban settings devoid of parks. In today's urban congestion, can towers answer both the need of spaces to live in and the possibility to enjoy outdoor qualities? We propose to re-distribute the park program into the building program, re-enacting the suburban ideal of the single family house linked by its garden into the very core of our densest centres. 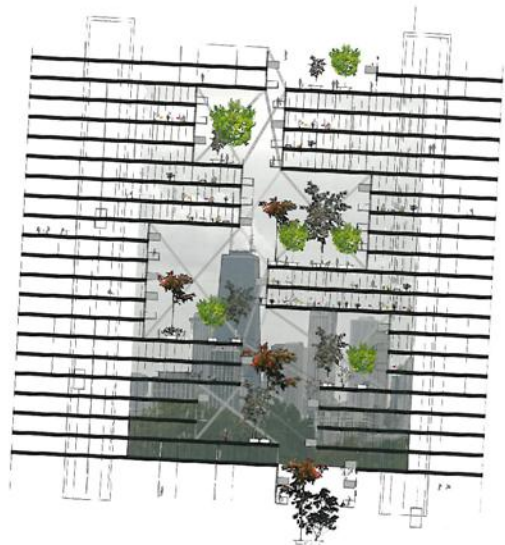
박스와 트리는 우리에게 수많은 공간에 몰려다님 대량 빌딩 속에 살 것을 제안한다. 20세기에 일어난 도시는 '언제나 타워엔 베란다'가 아니라 대량 빌딩 숲과 같다. 그리고 건물은 도시 공간의 사회적 상호작용을 감소하고 오히려 그 열매를이 약화시킨다. 도시가 밀집 개발된 대신, 우리 각자 공간과 광경을 빼앗겼다. 공간의 중요성을 공간이 가진 중요한 도시 공간으로 재조명한다. 오늘날의 건물 밀집 속에서, 타워가 공간의 타워 숲과 몇 가지 환경을 즐길 수 있는 가능성에 무엇일 수 있을까? 우리는 고층에서 정원을 채우고 서로 거주하는 가장 밀집된 도시간에 살 수 있게 한다. 공원 프로그램을 빌딩 프로그램으로 재분배할 것을 제안한다. 우리는 미래의 삶의 DNA에 공원이라는 요소를 추가할 것을 제안한다. JOURN DE STREET was born on December 31st 1975 in Brussels, Belgium to French architect Jacques Ledoux and Belgian artist Claude De Smet. After spending months in London, US, San Francisco, San Carlos, Paris, Berlin and Los Angeles (CA) and London, in 1985 he started his studio from the Gerrit School of Architecture in 1989. During 1987-1998 and 2000-2001, he worked at OMA, Rotterdam (1987-1988) where he founded the office PL07. Among other awards and recognitions, he has received the Pritzker Lifetime Prize in 2003 and the Ebeling Award in 2005. In 2006 the Rotterdam Concept Hall was awarded 'world's best work' at the Venice Biennale and the best of youth award was awarded for the M&M van der Stoep house and won the M&C award in London in 2006. Jan De Smet founded his current office, JDS, in Copenhagen. In 2007 he won the Pritzker trial competition for a new Helsinki City Hall in Oulu, Norway. JDS awarded a 10th office in Brussels in 2008.

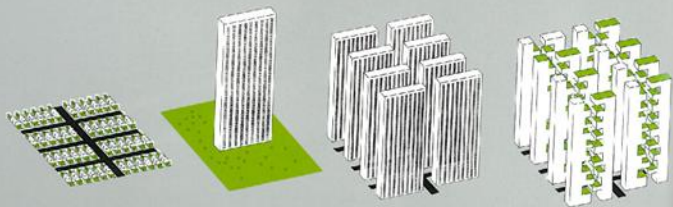

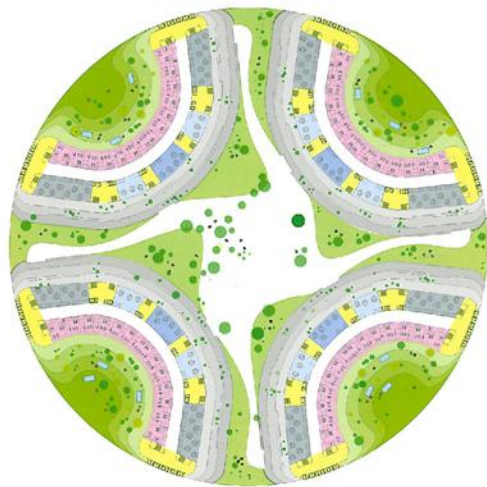
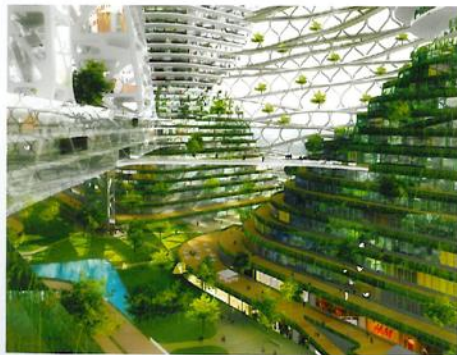

>> URBAN EVOLUTION DIAGRAMS

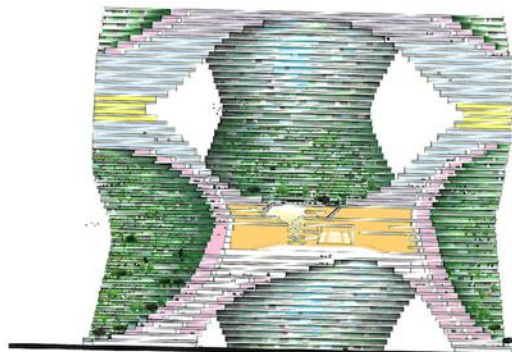
