A runway show installation was designed and built for fashion designers Vilsbøl de Arce as a visual parallel to their collection focusing on the theme of anatomy. The collection offers a reinterpretation of the human body, abstracting anatomical elements and assigning them new formal and functional definitions. The themes in the collection were translated into spatial strategies for the installation; a spiral of striated wooden bands wraps itself around the runway, enclosing the models inside an expanding and contracting organism.
